

Recommended Puppy Care Vaccine Schedule:

~8 - 10 weeks of age:	DAP (Distemper, Adenovirus, Parvovirus) Oral Bordetella
~12 - 14 weeks of age:	DAP Leptospirosis Lyme
~15 - 16 weeks of age:	DAP Leptospirosis Lyme Rabies

Leptospirosis, Lyme and Bordetella vaccines are boostered annually. Rabies and DAP are boostered one year after the initial vaccine, then every three years.

Heartworm Test and Prevention

We strongly recommend a 4DX test (blood test that tests for heartworm, lyme, anaplasa and ehrlichia) annually for all dogs over the age of 1 year. Heartworm preventative should be given to all puppies and dogs year-round.

Intestinal Parasite control

We strongly recommend a fecal exam at 6-12 weeks of age and annually thereafter. We recommend deworming puppies every 2 weeks until they are 12 weeks old. We recommend administering monthly parasite prevention to all dog's year round (This is often included in the heartworm preventative).

Flea & Tick control

We strongly recommend the use of flea and tick control products in all dogs all year round, especially those that spend a large amount of time outdoors or are used for hunting.

<u>Surgery</u>

We recommend spaying (female) or neutering (male) between 6 and 12 months of age; It may benefit larger breed dogs to wait closer to 9-12 months of age.
